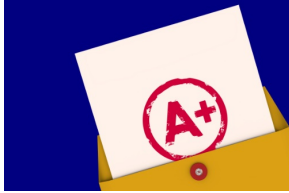

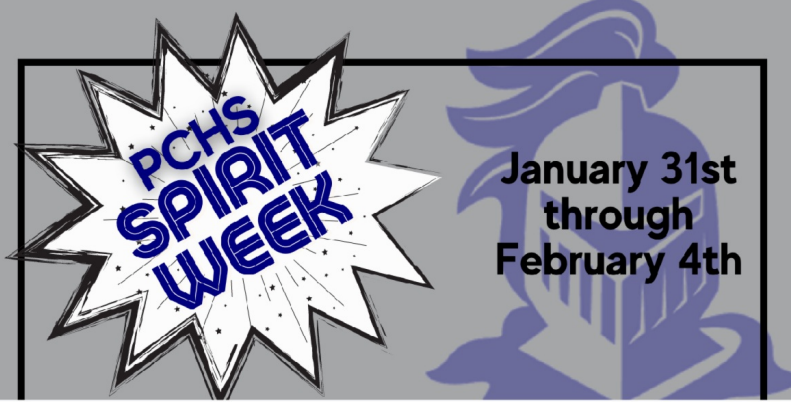
#### **Outside Guests:**
